The closest airports are located in</p> <p><b>Sibiu</b> (SBZ) - 140 km west of Brasov - <a href="http://www.sibiuairport.ro">www.sibiuairport.ro</a></p> <p><b>Targu Mures</b> (TGM) - 170 km north of Brasov - <a href="http://www.targumuresairport.ro">www.targumuresairport.ro</a></p> <p><b>Bucharest</b> (OTP) - 160 km south of Brasov - <a href="http://www.otp-airport.ro/index.php">www.otp-airport.ro/index.php</a></p> <p>If you arrive by plane in Bucharest, we can arrange transportation till Poiana.</p>
<p><b>By train</b></p>	<p><b>Brasov Train Station</b> (Gara Brasov) Address: Blvd. Garii 5</p> <p>There are 3 direct international trains from/to <b>Budapest</b>. One of them continues to <b>Vienna</b> and another to <b>Bratislava</b> and <b>Prague</b>.
